


NS LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES 2011-2020; REGISTERED VS. EMPLOYED



The supply of LPNs in 2020 was 4,663, a slight decrease of -0.4% (-19) since 2019, and increase of 6.1% (269) in the last 5 years and 25.4% (994) in the last 10 years.





Age Distribution and Employment Status (2020)



- The LPN workforce is well balanced in 5-year age group distributions.
- There is a large portion of this workforce in part-time and casual positions across all age groups.

Since 2018, the proportion of LPNs <35 years, and those ≥50 years has remained relatively stable, while those 35-49 years has increased slightly.
